

Preparing to Teach in Education and Training Award level 3

Course Overview

The Level 3 Award in Education and Training is an introductory teaching qualification. It was previously known as PTTLS. The award is appropriate for teachers, tutors and trainers who may be working, or intend to work, within an FE college, adult and community learning centre or learning provider and for those delivering work-based training such as within voluntary, community, private and public organisations. This is a full cost course. There is no fee remission available and you cannot apply for an advanced learner loan to pay for your fees.

Entry Requirements

You are required to have English and maths skills at level 2. If you do not possess certificates in English or maths (GCSE A-C or equivalent) then a short written test will be required.

On successful completion of this qualification, you can progress onto the Level 5 Diploma in Education and Training if additional requirements are met. Opportunities are also available to specialise in English, maths or e-learning as part of a progression route which will help in gaining a place on the PGCE/Diploma if you don't yet have a specialist qualification.
