

Leadership and Management Higher National Certificate (HTQ)

Course Overview

Our Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Leadership and Management is equal to the year 1 of a Degree (Level 4) and aims to develop you into an independent-thinking professional who can meet the demands of employers and adapt to a constantly changing business world. This programme is taught over 30 weeks, with approximately 14 hours completed each week. Delivered by experienced staff, the selection of HNC units provides core insight into leadership and different business management functions suited to many types of industries. A flexible approach to teaching and learning ensures that lectures, workshops, and academic and pastoral tutorials help support you along your academic journey. This course seeks to widen your access to higher education and to improve career prospects by developing core skills and knowledge that prepare you to enter employment with the qualities necessary for job roles that require some personal responsibility. After completing the 1 year HNC course you are also able to progress onto the level 5 Higher National Diploma (HND) in Leadership and Management, to give you more advanced knowledge, employability skills and behaviours.

Entry Requirements

Standard entry to this course requires references, and four GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and maths (or level 2 Functional Skills). A minimum of grade 4/5 for maths would be an advantage due to course content. Consideration will be given to all applicants for 19 who hold equivalent English and maths qualifications. Due to the nature of this programme, you may be invited to attend an interview. Where necessary other means of an interview (i.e. telephone, web-based) can be arranged.
