Be able to understand and use the current IET regulations BS7671:2018 and have use of a copy of BS7671:2018.

How you will be assessed

Formative assessments and interactive quizzes will be carried out throughout the course on completion of each Part of the wiring regulations, you are expected to fully engage with these assessments. One multiple choice online test 60 questions.120 minutes are allowed. This is an open book assessment.
