Environmental Sustainability Award level 1

Course Overview

This is a supported online learning course which is all year (50 weeks of the year including non-term times). You will work on our IT workshop and study the units that make up this award, which could be one whole day or split over a few days. the course is designed so the days and times suit your personal commitments, and the learning is taken at your own pace and complete the assessment once they feel ready.

The aim of this course is to provide you with the knowledge and understanding of the basic principles of sustainability and environmental impacts. This qualification introduces key issues in sustainability, raising awareness of the topic and encouraging to consider your role in helping to make sustainable choices and be able to identify the local and global benefits of sustainable communities.

Particularly beneficial for you if you are 19+ and looking to work in the environmental sustainability sector including waste management, construction sector and businesses wishing to comply with current legislation.

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What you will learn

During this online course, you will learn about the following: $\langle br / \rangle \langle br / \rangle 1$) how to identify the main themes of sustainable development $\langle br / \rangle 2$) gain knowledge on excess energy consumption and the environmental problems this can cause. $\langle br / \rangle 3$) identify natural resources and explain their importance $\langle br / \rangle 4$) identify the sustainability issues surrounding natural resources $\langle br / \rangle 5$) how goods and services are created and the waste impacts the environment and methods used to reduce this impact, $\langle br / \rangle 6$) gain an understanding of energy and water usage and the ideas and technologies used to reduce usage.

There are no formal entry requirements, however, a reasonable level of literacy is expected i.e. you can write and speak to make yourself understood. It would be useful to be able to use a keyboard although support is available.

- Universal Credit
 - JSA or ESA (Employment and Support Allowance Work Related Action Group)
