# **Introduction to Upholstery Beginners 2**

#### **Course Overview**

This non-accredited course runs from St Margaret's Campus, each Monday, 9:30 - 12:00 for 9 weeks, starting on Monday 28 April and finishing on Monday 7 July 2025. <br /> <br /> This course builds upon your existing knowledge, equipping you with additional techniques to tackle upholstery projects. <br /> <br /> You may be required to bring some of your own materials to each session. <br /> <br /> You will also need to have a stool, dining chair, or an armless small chair to upholster.

### What you will learn

During this course, you will learn:  $\langle p \rangle \langle p \rangle$  - Understand health and safety, safe working practice regulations  $\langle p \rangle$  - Safely disassemble furniture  $\langle p \rangle$  - Remove old fabric and padding $\langle p \rangle$  - Install new webbing and foam  $\langle p \rangle$  - Measure, cut and secure fabric  $\langle p \rangle$  - Use techniques to create finishing trims.  $\langle p \rangle \langle p \rangle$  - Each week will develop these skills and guided by your tutor you will apply these to your chosen piece of furniture.

# **Entry Requirements**

This course is designed as an introduction to upholstery skills and is suitable for those that have completed our Introduction to Upholstery Beginners 1 Course or have some previous upholstery experience. <br/> <br/> /> <br/> You must be aged 19+ and be able to complete a short workbook on a weekly basis with the help of your tutor.

# How you will be assessed

There are no formal assessments, exams or coursework. Your tutor will informally assess your progress each week. <br/> <br/> <br/> <br/> You will receive a certificate of course completion based on your progress in class and attendance.

#### **Course Fees**
