

Introduction to Crafting and Making - Air Dry Clay

Course Overview

This non-accredited course runs from City Skills Centre, each Monday, 12:15pm – 2:45pm for 9 weeks, starting on Monday 28 April finishing on 7 July 2025. This is a beginner's course for people with limited experience of using air dry clay. As you develop there will be a choice of projects to match different abilities.

What you will learn

During this course, you will learn: - How to use various techniques with air dry clay - Use of modelling tools and equipment safely - How to use various painting techniques - How to use of form and dimensions to create unique products - To create preliminary drawings to aid creating a piece of art This is a tutor led course. However, students can choose their own project in week 8 and 9.

Entry Requirements

This course is designed as an introductory course and no previous skills or experience is required. You must be aged 19+ and be able to complete a short workbook on a weekly basis with the help of your tutor.

How you will be assessed

There are no formal assessments, exams or coursework. Your tutor will informally assess your progress each week. You will receive a certificate of course completion based on your progress in class and attendance.

Course Fees

The cost of the course is £90.00. However, you will not be required to pay a fee for this course if you are in receipt of one of the following benefits: - Universal Credit - JSA or ESA (Employment and Support Allowance Work Related Action Group) There will be no fees if you earn less than £25,000.

Course Progression

You can only complete this course once. On completion of this course, you may progress onto one of the other Adult Engagement and Progression courses. Your tutor will advise and discuss the various progression routes available to you. You can also access the College Careers Team to support your progression.

What Happens Next

Apply online via the College website. You will be contacted to attend an interview if required or sent a conditional offer according to the course's entry requirements. You will then be invited to enroll for your chosen course.
