Entry Requirements

Entry to this course requires one reference. You should demonstrate a minimum of 90% attendance in your last place of study or work. You need a GCSE in English and maths, each at grade 3 or higher. You also need two more GCSEs at grade 3 or above. One of these must be a science or a technical subject.

by /> Students who studied with us need a level 1 Diploma in Plumbing or a level 1 Diploma in Construction Skills (BSE). They also need English and math at grade 3 minimum or equivalent Functional Skills.

by /> All students will undertake a monitoring period for the first six weeks of their programme. During this time, attendance, attitude, attainment, and application toward study will be monitored. A final decision as to the most appropriate level and outcome will be discussed with you towards the end of your first six weeks.

How you will be assessed

Assessment for this qualification is throughout the year. Each unit has it's own criteria and will generally consist of a combination of an on-line multi choice test and a practical assignment both set by City Guilds. There are 10 units to achieve to complete the diploma.

Course Fees

You will be required to purchase some basic equipment to support your learning and protect you during normal working practice in the workshop. Approximate combined cost for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and tool kit of £85. Previous Leicester College students may only require a top-up tool kit at a reduced cost. You will be advised what is required during the application process. There may be an additional examination registration fee of approximately £155.00 if applicable. Re-sits for applicable examinations are chargeable.
