

## Dementia Awareness level 1

### Course Overview

During this one day course you will explore how to provide basic care for people living with dementia, including understanding what dementia is, its common signs, and symptoms and basic strategies of how to support an individual living with dementia. This course is designed to provide a basic awareness so would be helpful CPD for people in various public facing roles.

### What you will learn

The aim of this short course is to provide an introduction to the concept of dementia and providing person-centred support. The learning aims of the course are:

- Understanding the most common types of dementia.
- Understanding what the signs and symptoms of common types of dementia are.
- Understanding what good practice looks like when caring for an individual with dementia.
