

Creative Hand Embroidery Fabric Sampler Book

Course Overview

These sessions are based in the textiles workshop at St Margaret's campus. This is a non-accredited course and suitable for beginners and students with some knowledge of hand embroidery. Start date on Thursday 16 April and ending on 4 June 26 for 8 weeks 1pm to 4pm. This is a friendly relaxed course set in a creative workshop. It is a tutor led course and is designed to help develop skills to create a final piece personal to you or as a gift for a budding embroiderer. Each week you will learn/develop a number of embroidery stitches (supported with handouts) and you will be guided through the design and making process to produce your fabric sampler book. All materials will be supplied.

What you will learn

Health and Safety and Safe working practice within the workshop. Learn/develop and have an understanding of a range of hand embroidery stitches. Create a personalised front and back cover for your sampler book. Gain the skills to design and make a final piece. Develop your confidence and skills for future projects.

Entry Requirements

This course is designed for beginners and learners with knowledge of hand embroidery. You must be aged 19+

Course Fees

Annual Tuition fee: £150 This course is a full cost course total of £150

You can only complete this course once and your tutor will advise and discuss the various progression routes available to you. You can also access the college careers team to support your progression and direct you to other courses and we may run other base textiles course in the future.
